HOW TO BECOME A CERTIFIED JUDGE FOR ACHF, Inc.

In order to become a certified judge for ACHF, Inc. you must (a) attend a judges training class held at EXTREME annually AND (b) apprentice a minimum of two competitions within one year (1 being with a rep). Please contact President Elliot Skeen for more information.

Update:

Due to the transition of ACHF, Inc. to become a legally recognized entity, a moratorium was placed on the judges list shown on the website. As of July 1, 2019, the following criteria must be met to be added or maintain standing on the ACHF, Inc. Judges list.

- Anyone who completed the last judges training held prior to the incorporation of ACHF, Inc. (12/05/2017) and did successfully complete their apprentice judging will be voted on by the Board at the next meeting and added to the approved judges list.
- Anyone who completed training at EXTREME in 2018 will need to successfully complete two
 apprenticeships no later than June 30, 2020. Once completed, the Board will vote and you will
 be added to the approved judges list.
- If you were a judge with the former organization, the Board will require you to be recertified through a new judges training as many rule changes have taken place. You will not have to complete any apprentice judging. The Board will vote and you will be added to the approved judges list. A rep or scorekeeper may evoke the right to require you to attend further training if they feel it is necessary.
- Anyone currently on the judges list will be required to complete a refresher training every 5 years in order to maintain standing.
- All judges must be 18 years of age and must have experience as being a dancer on a competitive team for a minimum of two years or have been a director of a competitive team.

It is imperative as a judge for ACHF, Inc. that you commit to being fair and to have impartial judgement. We commit to our team directors that their dancers will be judged by a panel of professionals who commit to keeping their knowledge of rules up to date by attending continuing educational training.

We also expect our judges and reps to evoke a completely unbiased opinion of what is being presented before them to judge and score.

The board is tasked with placing a person in a position of trust that has only the best interest of the organization as the utmost priority and will serve for the betterment of moving ACHF, Inc. to its future. The Board reserves the right to have a majority vote on anyone wishing to hold a position within the organization including but not limited to all committees, board positions, judging panels, and advisory boards.
